Things to remember when signing up for confirmation classes:

- You have three years to complete your classes, so you need not do everything all at once.
- There are 12 classes you must take: 7 core classes and 5 elective classes.
- You are encourage to sign up for extra electives. If you sign up for one class each session for three years, that would allow for three extra electives.
- Record the classes you take on the form on the back of this guide and hang it up somewhere in your home as a reminder.

Core Classes:

<u>Class</u>	<u>Description</u>	<u>Offered</u>
New Testament	Study the story of the New Testament from Jesus' birth through the growth of the early church. This class includes written assignments and exams.	Session 1
Old Testament	Study the story of the Old Testament from creation through the prophets. This class will include homework and written exams/assignments.	Session 1
10 Commandments	Study the 10 commandments using Luther's Small Catechism. This course will include memorization and written exams/assignments.	Session 2
Apostles' Creed	Study the Apostles' Creed using Luther's Small Catechism. This course includes memorization and written exams/ assignments.	Session 2
Sacra-ments	A study of Baptism and Holy Communion using Luther's Small Catechism. This course will include memorization and written exams/assignments.	Session 3
Lord's Prayer	A look at the prayer that Jesus taught his disciples to pray. This class uses Luther's Small Catechism and will include Memorization and written exams/assignments.	Session 3
Worship	Study the different parts of worship and why we do them. This class will include written homework and exams.	Session 5
